The 124th Japanese Society of Animal Science (JSAS) symposium was held at Tokyo University (Yayoi Campus, Tokyo) from 28th to 30th, March, 2018. Four students from LAPC finishing their Master's degree presented their own research at the symposium. The presentation titles were: "Development of immunobiotic evaluation system of PIE cells stimulated by DSS" (Nana Sato), "Research on adhesion property of Bifidobacteria strains to human intestine" (Binghui Zhou), "TLR2 and 4 ligands stimulate inflammation / adipogenesis in porcine adipocytes" (Manami Igata), and "Research on antiport of lactose take-in of Lactobacillus bulgaricus and development of galactose decreased yogurt" (Kosuke Yamada). Nana Sato, Binghui Zhou, and Manami Igata, who presented in English, were awarded "English Presentation Award" from the JSAS Scientific Committee.
